



Quality Control (QC) Checklist

This checklist ensures a thorough review of all podcast production elements ensuring the episode is polished, professional, and ready for release.

1. Watch the entire video episode to check for:

- Correct intro and outro.
- Any visible or audible technical issues, glitches, or background noise.

2. Listen to the audio file after reviewing the video to:

- Ensure that the audio matches the video (no out-of-sync issues).
- If discrepancies are found, communicate with the editing to verify and update as needed.

3. Review the episode's cover art and short video clips:

- Check if all text (e.g., show name, episode title) is correct.
- Confirm the images are aligned with the episode and correctly represent the content.

4. Thoroughly review the show notes for:

- Misspelled words.
- Grammatical errors.

5. Double-check the episode summary:

- Ensure the Guest name and Podcast Show name are correct.

6. Check all the links in the show notes:

- Ensure they are correct and functional.
- If incorrect links are found, verify with the client to update.
- Ensure that all resources mentioned by the guest and host are included

7. Once all checks are complete:

- Forward the show notes and the episode to key stakeholders for final approval.
